

# Hahnemühle Varnish – Glossy / Satin / Matt

#### Content

Pure-acrylate dispersion, water, additive Varnish Glossy and Varnish Satin contain additional matting agent.

### Product description

- Protective coating for inkjet prints on canvas
- Suitable for art prints and photography
- Protects from dirt and humidity

#### Properties

## Application

Hahnemühle Varnish can be applied easily with a hand roller directly onto the canvas inkjet print. Make sure your prints are completely hard-dried (we recommend allowing the print to dry 24 hours prior to varnishing), as well as dust and lint-free. Before use, thoroughly stir Hahnemühle Varnish for at least 2-3 minutes to achieve an even consistency. Pour a small amount into a roller tray and saturate a foam roller evenly. Using consistent pressure, start rolling in different directions until the entire print is coated. Let Hahnemühle Varnish dry for 2-3 minutes, and then roll the entire area once again – this time without pressure. About 30 minutes later, Hahnemühle Varnish will become dry to the touch.

Please note: The drying time depends on the thickness of the layers and other factors such as humidity, air circulation and ambient temperature. We recommend allowing the print to rest overnight.

## Handling instructions

- Hahnemühle Varnish Glossy / Satin / Matt are water miscible, but dry water insoluble. Completely dry after 24 hours.
- Shake before use.
- Ready-to-use mix, but can be mixed with a maximum of 10% distilled water if needed.
- Clean tools directly after use with water or water and soap.
- Don't apply the product at room temperatures below 10°C (50°F).
- Store in a cool dry place.
- Protect product from freezing.
- Test before apply on non Hahnemühle media.
